We're making progress on several **key community projects:** 

- **Business Fair:** To showcase and support our local businesses, we're planning a business fair at Roman Park. A working committee was formed, and a survey carried out to gauge the interest. Thank you those who responded we will review the feedback and publish next steps in the coming months.
- More trees and hedges across Berryfields: We are delighted that our application to the Woodland Trust for free trees has been approved. These will be planted in Roman Park and Parish-owned land once they arrive.
- **Book Swap Stores:** Green Ridge Primary and AVA schools have kindly agreed to host the book swap stores. Exact locations will be finalised before installation.
- **Electronic Speed Signs:** We have invested in a new solar-powered Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign (MVAS) to help improve road safety, with installation due in the coming months.
- **Bus Shelters:** We liaised with Bucks Council, Consortium and the bus company. All parties are in agreement to go ahead with this. There are still steps to complete and funding to secure, but we'll keep you updated.
- Roman Park Improvements: We're in the early stages of planning exciting improvements at Roman Park, including a new car park, landscaping, and more. The car park in particular will make life much easier for allotment holders. Updates will follow as the project develops.

#### **Community Services**

• Roman Park Food Bank: The food bank is open every Thursday morning between 11am and 12.15pm. As winter approaches, we need your continued support through food donations and volunteers. Donations can be dropped off outside the hall at any time.

Finally, I'd like to wish all children a wonderful new school year and look forward to seeing you at our upcoming events.

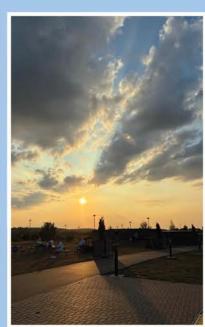














#### COUNCILLOR ALAGAPPAN MUTHU

## A GUIDE TO 11+ EXAMS

#### INTRODUCTION

The 11+ is an entrance examination that determines admission into grammar schools; some private schools also require a good 11+ score for admission. Many of you would be planning to take this examination at the beginning of your Year 6. I also wrote the 11+ exam and I now go to a grammar school. I wanted to share what I found helpful in preparing for the exam.

#### WHAT IS THE 11+

The 11 plus assesses what you know and have learnt along with problemsolving and logical thinking. Of the four sections, two (English & Maths) are taught at school and the other two are not. Both of the reasoning sections test you on problem-solving and logical thinking. Therefore, these skills need to be practiced at home.

#### Sections:

- · Verbal Reasoning
- · Non-Verbal Reasoning
- · English

#### **REVISION GUIDES & RESOURCES**

Effective revision is very important when practicing for the 11+ as cramming a lot of information will not be helpful. Except for the English section, all questions are multiplechoice. I have listed below what I found useful when revising.

#### **Recommended Resources:**

- CGP 11+ Books (Can't recommend this enough!)
- Schofield & Sims 11+ Books
- CGP Website
- Bond Website (Free, but an account is needed)

#### **MY EXPERIENCE**

From personal experience, I've found that consistency is key. Short, daily practice sessions are more effective than infrequent, long study periods. I also found doing past papers or practice papers really helpful. When you come to a question you don't know, don't quess. Instead, circle it and move on. Once you've marked your paper, return to the ones you got wrong or couldn't do. Write down what section and kind of question they were, then find focused practice questions to work on those exact weak spots.

#### TIPS & ADVICE

- Create a study schedule: Set up a daily study schedule for yourself. Make it a goal to practice for one hour every day, either in the morning or after school.
- Practice papers: Free practice papers available online or a paid one such as Exam Happy that I used are extremely helpful in adjusting to the test.
- Timing: Once confident, try timing yourself
- Separate notebooks: Designate one (at least) notebook for just 11+ notes or one for each section.
- Stay positive: Be consistent, put FULL effort and you'll do great!

#### CONCLUSION

Preparing for the 11+ exam requires a lot of dedication and effort. By understanding the exam format, making use of the resources available to you and implementing preparation tips, you can significantly enhance your chances of success. Remember, the 11+ is just one step in your academic journey. Believe in your potential, stay focused, and give it your best shot! Good luck!

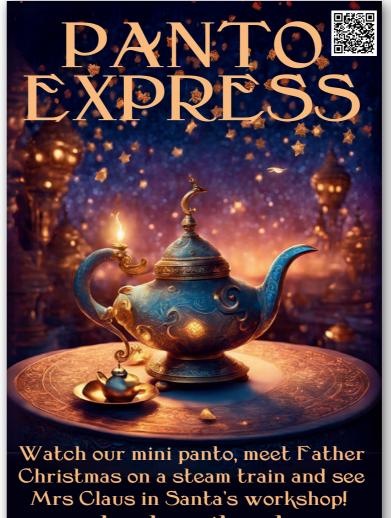

#### **COULD YOU HELP CHILDREN LEARN AND GROW?**

Recent census figures show that **the 1st Berryfields Scout Group has increased by over 16% in twelve months.** This is due to Scouting providing over 250 activities ranging from air activities to cooking, emergency aid to global issues and pioneering to water activities, leading to more children and young people hearing about these and saying, "How can I join?" The high numbers of children and young people wanting to join is due to the amazing programmes organised by volunteers.

With full sections, the Group has more than 100 young people who want to join the Group. The solution to being able to take them off the waiting list and into one of the sections is for more adults to volunteer.

Steve, Lead Volunteer for the Group said, "The Group provide a wide range of activities which the children and young people enjoy. We are looking for volunteers to help with Squirrels (ages 4 to 6), Beavers (ages 6 to 8) Cubs (ages 8 to 10), and Scouts (ages 10 to 14)."

There are also opportunities for people to volunteer for roles in the background. This could be with fundraising, trustee, administration, IT or just helping out when needed."

Volunteer Nigel said, "Volunteering with Scouts is a great opportunity to help young people learn and develop skills along with having fun and trying out new activities. It's also a great opportunity to learn and develop new skills yourself, make friends, try new activities and take pride in seeing young people develop."

He added, "As volunteers we can help put the foundations in place. We then encourage the children and young people to build upon them as they try new activities and learn skills for life. Children and young people want adventure, and we provide the opportunity to have those adventures. The increase in numbers shows we are providing activities and opportunities that young people want to do."



Nigel added, "Volunteering with any of the sections allows you to see changes in the character of young people, see them becoming more confident and see them coming out of their shells. As a volunteer, we can be a role model for children and young people. We can help them learn values and skills, have experiences, opportunities and challenges and interact face to face with others. We can help children to learn and grow and we can create experiences for young people."

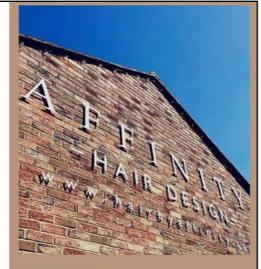

On behalf of Church on Berryfields, we wish you peace, love, and blessings this Christmas and New Year.

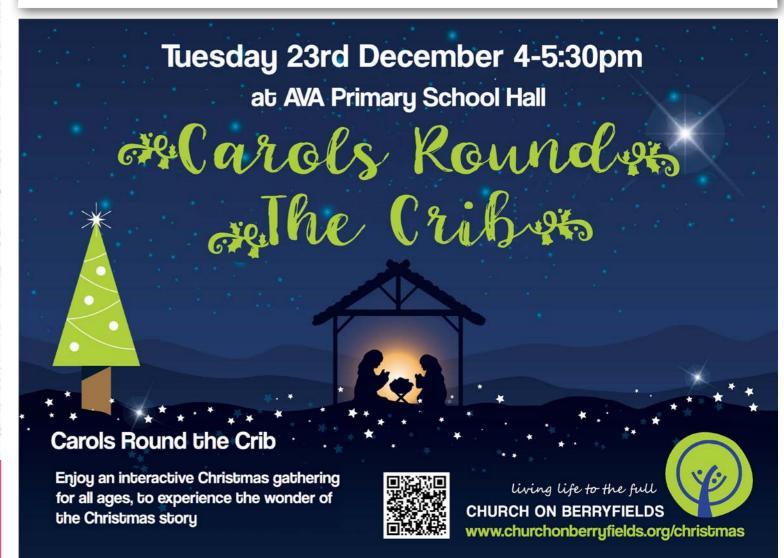

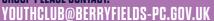

#### 'A SPACE TO GROW' by Kevin Roberts

I am currently studying Photography at Arts University Bournemouth (online), and my latest assignment involved creating a photographic series based on a local site. I chose the Berryfields Allotments, inspired by personal history. My dad has tended his own plot for over twenty years, and memories of watching him dig, tie beans, repair sheds, and share produce remain vivid. Photographing these allotments honours his dedication and celebrates the quiet, enduring value of these local spaces.

Visually, the allotments are captivating, featuring weathered tools and handmade structures that offer rich textures and colours. They tell stories of a slower, purposeful rhythm, creating intimate spaces where time stretches and nature is embraced.

















The assignment brought me joy in many ways. On a personal level, it enabled me to slow down and be present. Standing in the middle of a sunlit plot, camera ready, waiting for just the right moment, I discovered a calm I hadn't anticipated. It also renewed my appreciation for community—these spaces are filled with small acts of kindness, shared advice, and generous gestures. But most importantly, it gave me the chance to listen. The conversations I had while taking photos were often more powerful than the images. People opened up about their love and passion for their allotments, and their reasons for being a plot-holder are as varied as the plots themselves.

As the assignment approaches its conclusion, I reflect that it isn't just about vegetables and compost; it's about people, resilience, care, and joy. It's about the quiet victories that happen on ordinary patches of land. And I feel incredibly fortunate to have been invited to photograph it.
