# 24.3 **Open forum** (under adjournment)

A member of the public raised concerns regarding the Versailles boxes lining the cycle path being used for rubbish and attracting rats, and the lack of light along the pathway. The Chair commented that the boxes are due to be filled with soil very soon, and there are plans in place to install lights. Versailles boxes are addressed further in the minutes.

A member of the public raised strong concerns regarding a Starbucks planning application to erect a 7-meter illuminated pole sign just meters from his property, towering over his garden. Councillors agreed to strongly object on the grounds of possible light pollution and the potential increase in road traffic accidents referring to planning ref. 22/02401/AAD further in the minutes.

Cllr Waite gave updates on the Government's new housing numbers for Bucks with a 42% increase over the next 5 years; the homeless man with efforts to have the caravan removed from the layby; scooters being re-introduced into the town from 4<sup>th</sup> November; a £2.4m award for Helping Hands; and roadworks on the A41 to Bicester with no more closures due till this time next year.
